Qualifications:

Knowledge on coaching techniques and CIF-SS rules & by-laws is required. Coaching experience in CIF or any other state high school association with sanctioned games is desired.

Must possess or be willing to get current CPR/First Aid and NFHS coaching certificates.

Fluency in ASL is required.
